PRESS RELEASE

The Government of Cameroon has received funding from the World Bank (BIRD, Credit N° 8650-CM) within the framework of its Transport Sector Development Project, part of which is intended to provide training at Master's level in Transport Planning.

The Minister of State, Minister of Higher Education and the Minister of Public Works inform the public that the consortium comprised of the National Advanced School of Public Works (NASPW) of Yaounde in Cameroon, Université Libre de Bruxelles (ULB) in Belgium, the University of Padua and the University of Rome Sapienza in Italy has been selected to implement this Master's level training in "Transport Planning in Cameroon".

To this end, for the 2023/2024 academic year, the National Advanced School of Public Works (NASPW) is hereby launching a competitive examination for the selection of **80 students of Cameroonian nationality**.

Admission requirements:

- Be holder of a scientific Baccalaureate or GCE-ALs with at least two (2) science subjects obtained in one session;
- Be holder of at least a Bachelor's degree (BAC + 3 or GCE-ALs + 3) in Mathematics, Statistics, Computer Science, Physical Science, Civil Engineering, Rural Engineering, Economics or any other discipline related to transport;
- Have at least two (2) years of experience in the implementation of transport policies, plans and projects (for public and parapublic sector employees);
- Have an authorisation from his/her employer to follow the training (for public and parapublic sector employees).

Duration of the training: 4 semesters (2 years)

At the end of the training, a Master's degree in Transport Planning is awarded by the National Advanced School of Public Works.

Cost of the training: CFA F 935,000 per academic year.

N.B.: Part of the tuition fees is financed by the World Bank in the form of a grant of CFA F 650,000 per year and per student.

Course of the training:

The training whose courses are held online and on-campus at NASPW are taught by national and international teachers.

Composition of the application file:

- An application form to be collected from NASPW in Yaoundé or to be downloaded from the NASPW website (<http://www.enstp.cm>) ;
- A CV attesting to the professional and academic skills of the candidate;
- A letter of motivation;
- A certified copy of the birth certificate dated less than three months;
- An extract from the criminal record (Certificate of Non-Conviction) dated within the last three months;
- A professional document (certificate of employment, letter of recommendation, etc.);
- A medical certificate dated less than three (3) months old attesting that the candidate is fit to exercise the profession;
- An authorisation to compete (for public employees) issued by the user Minister;
- Certified true copies of diplomas or certificates of achievement (BAC/GCE ALs, Bachelor degree, Engineering Degree, etc.);
- Two passport-sized photographs;
- A receipt of payment to the account of NASPW-Yaoundé No. 13368060001-32 opened at BICEC of Centre, branch account: 06860 Yaounde, of the amount of CFA F 30,000 representing the examination fees and bearing the name of the candidate. Candidates residing outside Yaounde may pay the examination fees at their local BICEC branch. The transfer fees are at the expense of the candidate. A copy of the receipt shall be deposited at NASPW Yaounde together with the other documents.

Content and duration of the tests

Cycles	Paper	Duration
1 st compulsory part (40 points)	Mathematics (BAC/GCE ALs level), Aptitude Test, Notions in Transport, General Knowledge, French and English	3 hours
2 nd part of your choice (10 points)	Mathematics, Physics, Statistics, Computer Science, Civil Engineering, Rural Engineering and Economics (BAC/GCE ALs + 3 years level)
